Description:

MILAGRO Project Observatory (<https://observatory.milagroproject.eu/>) is a sub-website of the MILAGRO Project (<https://milagroproject.eu/>) that observes various organizations that are involved with migrants.

The main feature of the website is the map showing the locations of the organizations. The base map is based on the OpenStreetMap map, that is available under the Open Data Commons Open Database License (ODbL), while the information about the organizations is provided by the MILAGRO Project. Basic information about the organizations is shown on the map itself, and additionally, each organization has its own page with more details.

On this page, the narrative information about the organization is entered as rich text, while the structured data is entered as metadata that is displayed in a way convenient for the website visitors. This enables easy editing for the MILAGRO Project editors, comprehensible view of the information for the website visitors, and the ability to import or export the data in the future. Each organization page is also accessible from the website menu.


A useful feature of the website is that by pressing on the coordinates of an organization on a smartphone device, the device should open them in its own map software, that could later be used to show a route to the organization and for similar purposes.

The website otherwise has the same features as the main website.


It is also possible to access the Observatory portal from the main project website, where the Observatory page is indicated.

As with the main website, it is clearly indicated that this is part of an EU-funded project via its appropriate disclaimer.


01 MILAGRO observatory start.png The start page of the Milagro Project Observatory.
